Students are trained using active learning methods that promote practical skills such as: information analysis, problem solving, individual and group decision making, team management, negotiation, communication.

There are many international students studying at WSFiZ. WSFiZ's multicultural environment contributes to the development of language competences and gaining experience in intercultural communications, which are nowadays necessary in the context of globalization.

The student has the opportunity to study one of the following programs.

Scheme of the educational process:

1st program. Admission to WSFiZ from the 1st year of study.

1st year of study– studying at KazHLIU (in Russian or English)

2nd year of study

- Fall semester – in Poland (in English)

- Spring semester – at KazHLIU (in Russian or English)

3rd year of study

- Fall semester – at KazHLIU (in Russian or English)

- Spring semester – in Poland (studies in Poland are finished) (in English)

4th year of study - studying at KazHLIU (in Russian).

Upon completion of the program, the student receives 2 diplomas from **WSFiZ and KazHLIU**.

2nd program. Admission to WSFiZ from the 2nd year of study.

1st year of study– studying at KazHLIU (in Russian)

2nd year of study

First semester – at KazHLIU (in Russian or English)

3rd year of study– in Poland (in English)

4th year of study – studying at KazHLIU (in Russian or English)

Upon completion of the program, the student receives 2 diplomas from **WSFiZ and KazHLIU**.

The tuition fee for the Polish program is € 2200 for the entire period.

The cost of study in this program at KazHLIU depends on the language of instruction: in English – € 1500 per year, in Russian - the cost of study at KazHLIU in the chosen specialty

Note! When a student studies at a Polish university, he does not pay tuition fees to KazHLIU, payment only in WSFiZ.

The cost of the program does not include the cost of air travel, visa, medical insurance, and accommodation during the study period in Poland.
